6. **Changes to level play advanced rules (LPAC) AC B league** - Proposed by Ivan Wheatley

Following consultation with clubs and individual players over the course of the season two amendments to the league rules in connection with the AdvB league are proposed:

Proposal 1: Teams entering the AdvB league may comprise one or more clubs by prior agreement at the start of the season and members of any one of the combined clubs will be eligible to play for the combined team.

Proposal 2: The minimum individual player handicap be increased to 1 with one of the players (player 3) having a minimum handicap of 3. The format of the match will be one doubles game with each team comprising player 3 and one other player and the singles games matched in handicap order as far as is possible. The minimum aggregate team handicap to remain at 6.

7. **Amendment to League Rules** – proposal from Southport & Birkdale Croquet Club
S.B.C.C. propose that corner pegs are used in all Federation League matches, except Golf.

The rationale is that when, for example, a player wants to place a ball just outside the corner and is some distance from that corner, then a peg helps the player to be accurate in their shot. Whilst the Laws do not require the provision of corner pegs, we believe that they are needed in both full and short lawns.

8. **Admission to Membership – proposal by Paul Rigge**
General Meeting is requested to confirm a) Criccieth Tennis & Croquet Club and b) Stoneyhurst College as members of NW Federation.

9. **Subscriptions – proposal by Liz Wilson**
Subscriptions to remain unchanged.

10. **Amendment to Constitution** - proposal from Southport & Birkdale Croquet Club

S.B.C.C. propose the following change to the Federation Constitution.

6 e) line 3 after "and Executive Officers may speak and vote" add, "however, if a proposal is submitted by a club, only club representatives may vote."

The rationale is that Federation Executive Officers and Officers could have 2 votes on any formal proposal that a club puts to the A.G.M.

The Federation Secretary informs clubs of the proposal in advance of the A.G.M. and the matter is discussed by clubs and a vote taken. Their representative is then mandated to vote accordingly on the proposal at the A.G.M. Executive Officers and

Officers of the Federation will then have voted on the proposal in their clubs. When the proposal is discussed at the A.G.M. then the Executive Officers and Officers are allowed to vote again thus giving them a second vote which could cancel out their entire club's vote.
